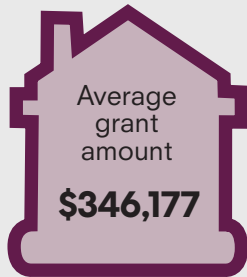
OBJECTIVES:

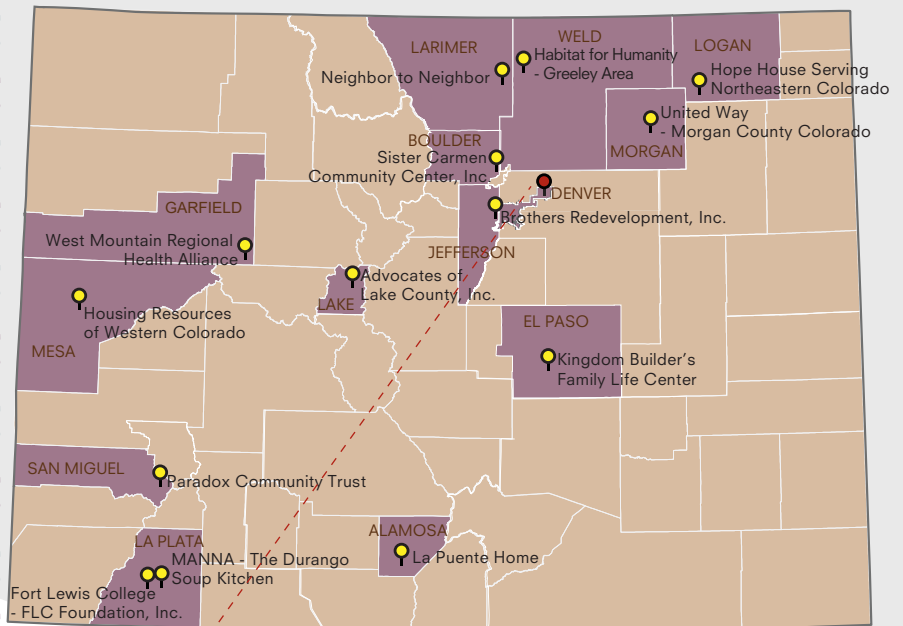
